INTRODUCTION

The exciting Book of Daniel is well known, containing many of the Bible stories we heard as children. From the story of Daniel in the lion's den, to Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego in the fiery furnace, to the single hand writing on the wall, the book of Daniel offers drama like no other. It begins with young men being taken captive from Jerusalem and brought to Babylon, the domain of King Nebuchadnezzar, where he planned to indoctrinate the young men into the Babylonian ideology. But we read in Daniel 1:8 that "Daniel resolved not to defile himself." You see. Daniel believed in, and was committed to the Holy One of Israel, the One True God, and he was determined to not lose sight of who he belonged to.

The Book of Daniel is relevant for us today in that it gives great insight into who God is. It is richly embedded with different names of God and instruction on His character. And it is because of who God is that we are called to live lives that are honoring to Him. We want to think, speak, and act like we belong to the Lord of Heaven. Admittedly, it is hard to daily honor God in our corrupt culture, just as it was for Daniel. It will be important for us to prepare in advance for how we will react in difficult situations before being faced with choice points. Our goal through this study is to learn to "resolve" to not defile ourselves with the ways of this world, but to live as future citizens of heaven.

The second half of Daniel speaks to this heavenly perspective with prophecies about end-time events. We will read about mysteries which were never-before-known, and are sometimes hard to understand, but are events which set the stage for what our Eternal God has planned for the future. In Daniel Chapter 9, we will consider unique proofs that the events recorded in this book are historical facts concerning historical characters, and if they are trustworthy, then so must be the future prophecies. In light of all this, let's explore together, how we can resolve to live in a way that is pleasing to God.

ANCIENT BABYLON WAS LOCATED ON THE PLAIN OF SHINAR, BY THE EVPHRATES RIVER. TODAY THIS LOCATION IS 50 MILES SOUTH OF BAGDAD, IRAQ. BABYLON RECEIVED ITS NAME AFTER THE TOWER OF BABEL INCIDENT RECORDED IN GENESIS 11. RESOLVE: CONVICTIONS AND ACTIONS DECIDED UPON BEFORE TEMPTATIONS.

Read Daniel 1:9-16.
What was the official's concern?
What solution did Daniel offer? What was the result at the end of the trial period?
Consider what temptation you are facing in your daily life which could cause you to defile yourself in God's eyes. How could you specifically pray for help in this area?

PRAYER - We praise You God as The Holy One of Israel. Thank you for your Word which guides us in how to be holy in your sight. Give us resolve to not defile ourselves in the ways of this world. Amen.

DANIEL 1: THE SOVEREIGN GOD

SOVEREIGNTY IS A THEOLOGICAL TERM WHICH SPEAKS TO GOD'S DIVINE RIGHT TO RULE HIS UNIVERSE. HE EXERCISES HIS RIGHT OVER NATURE, HISTORY, AND MANKIND. NOTHING HAPPENS WITHOUT HIS PERMISSION. IN SHORT, GOD IS IN CONTROL. THE WESTMINSTER CONFESSION OF FAITH STATES THAT, "GOD FROM ALL ETERNITY, DID, BY THE MOST WISE AND HOLY COUNSEL OF HIS OWN WILL, FREELY, AND UNCHANGEABLY ORDAIN WHATEVER COMES TO PASS." THE SOVEREIGNTY OF GOD, OVER THE NATIONS OF THE WORLD AND HUMAN AFFAIRS. IS A MAJOR THEME IN THE BOOK OF DANIEL.

DANIEL 2

Daniel was a prophet. A prophet was someone who was called by God to speak on His behalf. God would directly reveal His word and will to His prophet, often through dreams or visions. In the book of Daniel, we do not get to see God's call to Daniel to be a prophet, but we do know he was given the unique ability to "understand visions and dreams of all kinds." (Daniel 1:17) Being a prophet was a great honor, but one which required courage, because delivering God's messages, often to rebellious people, was dangerous. Looking at prophets in the Old Testament, we see that they were people with great intelligence, who were dedicated to God, and were prayer warriors for God's people. Prophets not only foretold future events, but also forthtold messages to the people of their day. Prophets would call the people of their generation to trust God, obey Him, and to submit to His will. A true prophet's predictions would prove to be 100% accurate. If a prophet's prediction did not come true, it meant he was a false prophet. (See Deuteronomy 18:20-22.)

It is interesting to note that although God revealed Himself through dreams and visions in the Old and New Testaments. we do not experience this type of revelation often in our Western World today. The reason is probably because we are blessed with the full revelation of God's Word in the Bible. But, we read in Joel and Acts that there will come a day when the Lord says, "I will pour out my Spirit upon all people. Your sons and daughters will prophesy. Your young men will see visions, and your old men will dream dreams. In those days I will pour out my Spirit even on my servants, men and women alike, and they will prophesy...before the great and glorious Day of the Lord." (Acts 2:17-18,20; Joel 2)

This week we will read about Daniel's first opportunity to interpret a dream and to prophesy future events.

OUR GOD REVEALS MYSTERIES

SMALL GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTION

Read Daniel 2:24-30.

When God works through us, it is so easy to take the credit, but who did Daniel say revealed the meaning of the king's dream?

When something goes right at work, or home, or among friends, are you willing to speak up about what God has done, or do you find this difficult?

Read Daniel 2:31-35. In your own words, describe King Nebuchadnezzar's dream.
What can we learn about God from today's verses? (Daniel 2:24-35)

PRAYER - We praise you God as The Revealer of Mysteries, who knows the end from the beginning of all things. Thank you that in Scripture, you have shown us glimpses of things to come. Help us to understand what you want us to know, and to be ever watchful for the return of your Son. Amen.



DANIEL 2:36-49

Read Daniel 2:36-38.

King Nebuchadnezzar must have been very flattered by Daniel's opening remarks. But who did Daniel say was responsible for the king's power and glory?

THE KING'S DREAM OF A STATUE WAS GOD'S REVELATION OF THE SUCCESSIVE GENTILE NATIONS THAT WOULD RULE OVER ISRAEL. THE SECTIONS WERE DEFINED BY DIFFERENT METALS WHICH DECREASED IN VALUE FROM THE HEAD DOWN, BUT INCREASED IN STRENGTH UNTIL THE FEET. HERE IS THE INTERPRETATION FROM THE LIFE APPLICATION BIBLE:

GOLO HEAD	BABYLON CONQUERED JUDAH	605 B.C.
SILVER CHEST WITH 2 ARMS	MEDO-PERSIA CONQUERED BABYLON	539 B.C.
BRONZE BELLY AND THIGHS	GREECE CONQUERED MEDO-PERSIA (ALEXANDER THE GREAT)	331 B.C.
IRON LEGS	ROME CONQUERED GREECE	146 B.C.
IRON/CLAY FEET	BREAK UP OF THE ROMAN EMPIRE	476 A.D.

THIS PART OF THE PROPHECY WAS FUTURE TO DANIEL AND KING NEBUCHADNEZZAR, BUT HISTORY TO US. EVERYTHING CAME TO PASS JUST AS GOD REVEALED THAT IT WOULD. THE REST OF THE DREAM PREDICTS:

PRAYER - We praise you God as the Lord of Kings. We thank you God, for showing us over and over in Your Word, that you are trustworthy. Help us trust you today during our own uncertain times, and give us the courage to speak up about your greatness and truth. Amen.

In looking back through Daniel Chapter 2, identify the verses which speak of God as the One who reveals mysteries or secrets?

SMALL GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTION

In verse 30 we read that Daniel said, "As for me, this mystery has been revealed to me, not because I have greater wisdom than anyone else alive, but so that Your Majesty may know the interpretation, and that you may understand what went through your mind."

We get the sense that it is God's good pleasure to reveal mysteries to His people. Why do you think He does this?

Do you think there is value in examining the future prophecies in the Bible for us today? Why or why not?

MARK HITCHCOCK, IN HIS BOOK THE END, SAYS THAT, "WHILE ALL BIBLICAL PROPHETIC PASSAGES MAKE A UNIQUE CONTRIBUTION, THERE ARE THREE MAIN SECTIONS OF THE BIBLE THAT CONTAIN THE ESSENTIAL KEYS TO UNDERSTANDING THE FUTURE. THESE THREE SECTIONS ARE DANIEL, THE OLIVET DISCOURSE (MATTHEW 24), AND THE BOOK OF REVELATION."

It is a blessing to be able to study the first of these together as a church. Will you prayerfully ask the Holy Spirit to give you understanding of what these prophecies mean, the wisdom to know how they affect us today, and the faith to believe what God says will come to pass?

PRAYER - We praise you Lord as the God of Heaven, who has a plan for the end of human history and the beginning of your Kingdom on earth. Thank you for giving us sections of the Bible which will prepare us for what is to come. Help us trust you Lord, in our own day and age, when things get tough and are constantly changing. And help us to believe You have a future and a hope for your world. Amen.

DANIEL 3

Last week, we read about the Babylonian King's dream of a huge metal statue. Daniel interpreted the meaning of the dream, including the part where the head of gold represented King Nebuchadnezzar. As we begin to look at Daniel Chapter 3, we will see this dream apparently gave the king a "brilliant" idea: why not build a real statue, and require the whole world to worship it? After all, 16 years had passed since the dream event, and the king probably thought that because of his great power, the prophecy would not come true. He might have doubted the silver kingdom would ever come, therefore, it was time to build a statue out of solid gold.

King Nebuchadnezzar did just that. He built a huge statue, yet failed to remember the God of Heaven had given him his power and glory. God alone had made the king ruler over the whole inhabited world (Daniel 2:36-38). This was quite a misjudgment on the king's part. Nevertheless, in Chapter 3, we will see not everyone agreed to follow the King's decree and bow down to the statue, there were some who resolved to worship God alone.

The Babylonians had no problem worshiping multiple gods. Last week, in Chapter 2, we saw even King Nebuchadnezzar acknowledged Daniel's God as one of the gods. (Daniel 2:47)
How do you see the same tolerance of multiple gods today?

PRAYER - We acknowledge you God as the One True God, for you alone are worthy of honor, worship, and praise. We thank you for the religious freedom we enjoy in this country. When this freedom comes under attack, show us the way forward, and give us the resolve to stand for you alone. Amen.

DANIEL 3:8-18

Consider how you would respond to someone who says it doesn't matter if people follow Buddha, Allah, or the Christian God because they are all the same. How can you prepare in advance for this question?
What have you learned from Daniel Chapter 3 that will help you resolve to trust in the God Who Saves, and worship Him alone?

PRAYER - Lord, you have become our Salvation. Thank you for being our strength and our song. Help us to trust you, and not be afraid, when we face the fiery trials of life. Amen. (Isaiah 12:2)

DANELA

Chapter 4 of Daniel is unique in all of Scripture, in that it was written by a pagan, King Nebuchadnezzar. This story was told from his point of view. We have seen that God chose Nebuchadnezzar for His purposes: to punish Judah for their disobedience. God told Judah if they worshiped pagan gods, and followed pagan practices, He would remove them from the promised land and send them into exile. Judah disobeyed in this way, and God sent Nebuchadnezzar to destroy Jerusalem, and take all but the poorest people to Babylon (see 2 Kings 24-25).

But, in His great mercy and grace, God also wanted
Nebuchadnezzar to know and believe in Him. God pursued the king, and revealed Himself to him through visions and dreams, and through the words of the prophet Daniel. God wanted the king to remember that He was the Most High God, who had given Nebuchadnezzar his power, glory, and dominion (Daniel 1:37-38).

In Chapter 4, we will see that God told the king what he could expect if he did not remember. He would be driven away from people, and live as an animal for seven years.

DANIEL 4: THE MOST HIGH GOD

THE TITLE "MOST HIGH GOD" IS ONE FOUND IN THE OLD TESTAMENT, MAINLY IN THE BOOKS OF PSALM, ISAIAH, AND DANIEL. THIS TITLE SPEAKS TO GOD'S MIGHT AND POWER. GOD HAS UNIVERSAL RULE OVER HEAVEN AND EARTH, WHICH INCLUDES ALL NATIONS, LEADERS, AND INDIVIDUAL LIVES. HE IS SUPREME, AND HE IS ETERNAL, SO HIS RULE WILL NEVER END.

Looking back through Daniel Chapter 4, which verses mention the Most High, and who called God by this name in each verse?

Through the events of this chapter, we see that Nebuchadnezzar did recognize God as the ultimate, eternal ruler of the universe. He realized his life was in God's hands. But the king was also the recipient of a different part of God's character, his compassion. When God warned the king of what was to come, He also told him it would be temporary (Daniel 4:27). Undoubtedly, to go through a "season of insanity" must have been a horrific experience, but God never forgot Nebuchadnezzar during that time. He did not look away while he lived as an animal, but guarded his "roots in the ground, and watered them with the dew of heaven." And when the seven years were fulfilled, God restored the king to sanity and to his throne, just as He said He would. Our God is the Most High God, but He is also slow to anger, patient, not wanting any to perish, but for everyone to come to Him (2 Peter 3:9).

The year was now 539 B.C., and Daniel had been a captive in Babylon for 66 years. We do not know how old he was when he arrived, probably a teenager, but by all accounts he would now be considered an old man. Nebuchadnezzar had died in 562 B.C., and Nabonidus was the current king, but he had chosen to live in Arabia. So, his son Belshazzar was co-regent and ruled in Babylon.

In this chapter, we will see that it was time for the fulfillment of the metal statue prophecy to begin. The silver nation was coming. In fact, it was quite possible that the Medo/Persian army was already amassing around Babylon. This scene opens with Belshazzar throwing a huge banquet for thousands. Perhaps he wanted to "eat, drink, and be merry," while there was still time. History tells us that it was the 12th of October. No doubt the mood was festive, the palace ablaze with torches, and the revelers could be heard throughout the city, but all came to a full stop as a single human hand began to write on the wall...

DAY 5

DANIEL 5: "THE LORD OF HEAVEN"

"THERE IS NO ONE LIKE THE GOD OF JESHURUN WHO
RIDES ACROSS THE HEAVENS TO HELP YOU,
AND ON THE CLOUDS IN HIS MAJESTY."

(DEUTERONOMY 33:26)

JESHURUN IS A NAME FOR ISRAEL, AND LITERALLY MEANS "THE UPRIGHT ONES."

In verses 22-23 of Chapter 5, we see that Daniel explained to Belshazzar why the hand had come to visit him. Daniel said, "But you Belshazzar have not humbled yourself...instead you have set yourself up against the 'Lord of Heaven'."

THE TITLE LORD OF HEAVEN, SPEAKS TO THE FACT THAT GOD IS HIGH AND EXALTED. WE SEE THIS NAME OF GOD OFTEN IN THE OLD TESTAMENT, ESPECIALLY IN THE BOOKS OF CHRONICLES, EZRA, NEHEMIAH, AND OF COURSE, DANIEL. FROM GENESIS 1, WE LEARN THAT HEAVEN CAN REFER TO THE EXPANSE ABOVE THE EARTH, WHICH HOLDS THE STARS. PEOPLE OF ALL TIME HAVE BEEN TEMPTED TO LOOK UP TO HEAVEN AND WORSHIP THE STARRY HOSTS— TO WORSHIP THE CREATION INSTEAD OF THE CREATOR. WE KNOW THE BABYLONIANS DID THIS (THEIR MOON GOD WAS CALLED AKU). BUT THE LORD OF HEAVEN WANTED THE BABYLONIANS TO RECOGNIZE HIM AS THE SUPREME POWER OF THE UNIVERSE, THE CREATOR OF HEAVEN AND EARTH, AND HE WANTED THEM TO WORSHIP HIM ALONE.

Read Daniel 4:37.
These were the last recorded words of King Nebuchadnezzar. How did he praise God in this verse? We cannot know for sure, but do you think he became a believer in the One True God?
Looking back over Daniel 5, how did King Belshazzar do the opposite of Nebuchadnezzar, and disregard The Lord of Heaven?
SMALL GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTION What would you like to praise The Lord of Heaven for this

Chapter 6 of Daniel marks a regime change. The Medo/Persian army defeated the Babylonians on the night of October 12, 539 B.C., and took over the country. It appears that Darius the Mede not only led the attack, but also stayed on as "king" for the Persian king, Cyrus. Darius' first order of business was to change the country from a monarchy into a provincial government.

Through all the upheaval, we will see that Daniel continued to be a man of high moral character, a man of integrity. Even though his captors were no longer in control of the nation, he stayed at his post. We will read how he continued to serve the new regime as faithfully as he had in the past. And most importantly, we will take an in-depth look at Daniel as a man of prayer.

IN THE LAW OF THE MEDES AND PERSIANS, ONCE THE KING MADE A DECREE, AND PUT IT IN WRITING, IT COULD NOT BE REVOKED EVEN BY THE KING HIMSELF, UNTIL THE TIME-LIMIT HAD EXPIRED. THIS WAS THE SAME LAW THAT ALMOST LED TO THE ANNIHILATION OF THE JEWS IN THE BOOK OF ESTHER (SEE ESTHER 1:19; 3:8-9).

THE ART OF PRAYER

"IN THE MORNING LORD YOU HEAR MY VOICE;

We were created with the privilege of communicating with God. Every great relationship is built on communication, and our relationship with the Lord is no different. Miraculously, if we spend time in prayer, we get to know the Lord better.

Effective prayer is always based upon Scriptural principles. It is important to let what we read in the Bible inform how we talk to God. Effective prayer contains different elements such as praise (for who God is), thanksgiving (for what He has done), confession, and petitions. The first three elements help put our hearts in the right place before we bring our requests to God. Jesus said that the "Father knows what you need before you ask Him," but even the Lord knew the necessity of prayer, and spent much time talking to His Father while He lived on earth. Spending time in concentrated prayer is a skill that can be developed over time.

Besides setting aside a special time for prayer, we should be prayerful people who communicate with the Lord as we walk through each day. Speak to Him about what is going on, send up "arrow prayers" for guidance, and intercede for others. Prayer is one of the richest spiritual blessings of our lives.

DANIEL 6: THE GOD WHO ANSWERS PRAYER

"BEFORE THEY CALL, I WILL ANSWER; WHILE THEY ARE STILL SPEAKING, I WILL HEAR." (ISAIAH 65:24)

It is true that our God is a God who answers prayer. Sometimes, He answers immediately, and sometimes we have to wait. Sometimes, He answers in the way we ask, and sometimes not. God is a creative God, who rarely answers the same prayer in the same way twice.

He said, "For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, but my word that goes out from my mouth will not return empty, it will accomplish what I desire, and achieve the purpose for which I sent it" (Isaiah 55:8,11).

SMALL GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Has there been a time when you saw God answer your prayer immediately?

Has there been a time that you had to wait for God's answer? (Maybe you are waiting for an answer now?)
Has there been a time when you thought God had not answered your prayer, but when you looked back over time, He was answering all along?
How has considering God's answers to prayer encouraged you in your faith today?

PRAYER - Lord, we praise you as the Omniscient, All-Knowing God. Thank you for your personal involvement in our lives. Help us to trust you in trials, and may we be ever aware of your presence. Amen.

Eschatology is the study of the End Times, meaning the events which lead up to the end of human history and the beginning of God's Kingdom. The Bible speaks about these events throughout the Old and New Testaments. Apocalyptic (end of world) literature contains distinct characteristics, such as visions, strange creatures, and signs. Time might seem to spiral, folding in on itself, only to start over. These passages can be difficult to understand and interpret, but often the Bible will give us an interpretation, either within the same passage, or in parallel passages, which speak about similar events. The only completely certain interpretations come from Scripture itself.

The Greek word apokalupsis, which can be translated as revelation, speaks to an unveiling, a revealing, or removing of a cover. It is apparent that God has included End Time prophesies in Scripture so that we will study them, learn from them, and watch for their fulfillment. (The End by Mark Hitchcock)

Here are some helpful definitions to keep in mind as we look at Daniel 7 and 8 this week:

The Tribulation: a seven-year period which will be an "age of wrath;" a time on earth of great suffering. This period will be marked by false prophets, the Antichrist, and severe natural disasters. These disasters are the "birth pains" of the end

The Antichrist: a world leader who will arise during an unsettled time, and promise the restoration of peace and prosperity. He will be attractive and well spoken, but he is evil. Halfway through the Tribulation, Satan will indwell the Antichrist, and he will then set himself up as God, and wage war on the Lord's people.

The Millennium: a thousand-year reign of Christ on the earth, which follows the Tribulation.

How did Daniel's dream begin?
Read Daniel 7:4-6.
Describe The Lion, The Bear, and The Leopard:

MANY SCHOLARS BELIEVE THAT THE FOUR BEASTS REPRESENTED THE SAME GENTILE NATIONS FORETOLD IN NEBUCHADNEZZAR'S STATUE DREAM. IF THIS WAS THE CASE, THE LION WOULD REPRESENT BABYLON, THE BEAR-MEDO/PERSIA, AND THE LEOPARD-GREECE. ARCHEOLOGISTS HAVE DISCOVERED PICTURES OF WINGED LIONS WHICH SYMBOLIZED BABYLON. IT COULD BE THAT THE STATUE DREAM DESCRIBED THESE NATIONS FROM A HUMAN PERSPECTIVE, WHILE DANIEL'S DREAM REVEALED GOD'S POINT-OF-VIEW: NATIONS BENT ON EVIL, WHICH WERE VIOLENT AND DESTRUCTIVE.

Read Daniel 7:7-8.
Describe the fourth Beast. What was on its head?

IT APPEARS THAT DANIEL DID NOT RECOGNIZE THE FOURTH
BEAST AS A KNOWN ANIMAL. THIS CREATURE WAS TERRIFYING TO
BE SURE. SCHOLARS FEEL THAT WHILE IT REPRESENTED ROME,
THE 10 HORNS POINT TO A FUTURE, END TIME PROPHECY.

SMALL GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTION

In verse 6 we see that the Leopard was given authority (for
a time). This verse speaks to the fact that God controls the
nations of the world, and He alone decides their scope and
length of rule. How does this encourage you about our day and
time?

TWO YEARS LATER, DANIEL HAD A SECOND VISION, AGAIN WITH ANIMALS
REPRESENTING GENTILE KINGDOMS. IN THIS VISION THE RAM WITH TWO HORNS
REPRESENTED MEDO/PERSIA, AND THE GOAT REPRESENTED GREECE. THIS VISION
EMPHASIZES TWO POWERFUL LEADERS: ALEXANDER THE GREAT OF GREECE, AND
ANTIOCHUS IV EPIPHANES OF SYRIA. ANTIOCHUS WAS AN ANTICHRIST WHO DEFILED
THE TEMPLE IN JERUSALEM BY ERECTING AN IMAGE OF ZEUS, AND OFFERING
A PIG ON THE ALTAR TO IT (AN ABOMINATION OF DESOLATION). WE WILL SEE
THAT HE WAS A FORESHADOW OF THE ANTICHRIST OF THE TRIBULATION.

Read Daniel 8:1-12 and 20-22.

Scholars believe that the little horn of verse 9 was Antiochus IV Epiphanes. From verses 9-12, what did he do once he came to power?

THE FIRST KING OF GREECE WAS ALEXANDER THE GREAT WHO SEEMED TO FLY ACROSS THE WORLD, CONQUERING EVERY NATION IN HIS PATH. HE DIED AT THE AGE OF 33, AND HIS FOUR GENERALS DIVIDED UP THE COUNTRY AND RULED IN HIS PLACE.

THE BEAUTIFUL LAND (ISRAEL)

Read Daniel 8:13-19.

The vision of the 2,300 evenings and mornings refers to the evening and morning sacrifices in Jerusalem's Temple. The wording is reminiscent of the Creation account in Genesis 1,

where each evening and morning equals one day. Therefore, we
are reading about a three year period.
Besides stopping the daily sacrifices, what did the holy ones
say would happen during this time frame?

PROPHECIES OFTEN HAVE SEVERAL FULFILLMENTS. THE FIRST ONES ARE USUALLY INCOMPLETE, LEAVING THE COMPLETE FULFILLMENT TO THE FUTURE.

Read Daniel 8:23-27.

WHEN EARTHLY WICKEDNESS REACHES ITS HEIGHT...

THE ANCIENT OF DAYS

The Ancient of Days is a title for God the Father which is only found in Daniel Chapter 7.

This title speaks of God as the Righteous Judge, seated on His throne for all time. God's justice is fair and impartial. His justice is complete in that the evil will be found guilty, and the innocent (those belonging to Christ) will be pardoned. At the end of time, The Righteous Judge will make all things right, including defeating the Antichrist.

Look back through Daniel 7.
Which verses speak of the Ancient of Days.
What thoughts do these verses give you about God the Father?

Daniel Chapter 7 compares the kingdoms of the world to God's Kingdom. Those who oppose God have a dire ending (see verses 11 and 26). It is vital that we come out on the right side of this, so please consider: Do you belong to the Lord's Holy People?

If you are unsure, will you pray and ask God to show you how to become a member of His family? Then ask your pastor, someone in your small group, or a friend, who you know to be a believer, to help you understand how to be saved.

Daniel was a historical figure, as was Nebuchadnezzar, Belshazzar, Darius, and Cyrus. This week we will look at biblical proofs which show these men actually existed. We will also watch as Daniel finds a prophecy in Scripture about his exile, which prompted him to pray, and confess the sins of Israel. And finally, we will look at new prophecies, some are history to us, and some are still in the future.

As we continue our study of Daniel, be on the lookout for words and phrases which signal end time events. Words such as: treaty, seven years, 3½ years, end of sacrifices, abomination of desolation, and the time of wrath... We must be wise, and we must be cautious as we discuss end times prophecy. In this chapter, the Archangel Gabriel came to give Daniel insight and understanding. As believers, we have the Holy Spirit to reveal truth to us. Jesus said, "All this I have spoken while still with you. But the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my Name, will teach you all things, and will remind you of everything I have said to you." (John 14:26)

JESUS SAID, "THE DAY IS COMING WHEN YOU WILL SEE WHAT DANIEL THE PROPHET SPOKE ABOUT-THE SACRILEGIOUS OBJECT THAT CAUSES DESECRATION STANDING IN THE HOLY PLACE." (MATTHEW 24:15)

We saw in this chapter that the Archangel Gabriel came to Daniel again, this time to explain the prophecies of the 70 "7's." From the study of the Old and New Testaments, as well as historical documents, scholars have developed a probable time-table for the prophecies:

- 1. Daniel 9:24 The total prophecy given by Gabriel contains 70 weeks. (70x7=490 years)
- 2. Daniel 9:25 From the decree to rebuild the temple, until the Anointed One comes will be: 7 weeks (49 yrs) plus 62 weeks (434 yrs). On March 5, 444 B.C., Artaxerxes Longimanus of Persia decreed that Jerusalem would be rebuilt (see Nehemiah 2:1-8). It took 49 years, and Jerusalem was completed in 395 B.C. Sixty-two weeks (434 years) later, Christ triumphantly rode into Jerusalem on a donkey on March 30, 33 A.D.
- 3. Daniel 9:26 Christ was crucified later that week, and in 70 A.D. the Romans destroyed the temple again. This concluded 69 weeks (7+62) of the prophecy.
- 4. Scholars think there is a gap between the 69th week and the 70th week which contains the "Church Age," the era which began at Pentecost and continues to this day. This age was a mystery to the Old Testament writers who thought Christ's first and second comings would be fairly close together. It was not until the New Testament times that the Church Age was revealed.
- 5. Daniel 9:27 This verse refers to a time future to us, when the Antichrist will rise to power during the Tribulation. This period will last for 1 week (7 years).

(Daniel, God's Plan for the Future by Chuck Swindoll)

THE ANOINTED ONE

To anoint means to set apart for special use or service. Jesus was the ultimate Anointed One in that He was set apart by God the Father to accomplish salvation for mankind. We see this mission reflected in Jesus's names; in Hebrew, anointed is translated Messiah, and in Greek it is Christ. In Old Testament times, anointing was done by pouring oil on a person's head, but in the New Testament, we see that anointing was done by the Holy Spirit. Although Christ was chosen to be the Savior before the creation of the world (Revelation 13:8), we read in the Gospels that He too was anointed by the Holy Spirit. "After his baptism, as Jesus came up out of the water, the heavens were opened and He saw the Holy Spirit of God descending like a dove and settling on him. And a voice from heaven said, 'This is my dearly loved Son, who brings me great joy.' " As believers, we are Christ's anointed, set apart as His ambassadors.

DANEL 10-11-35

It was 536 B.C., the third year of King Cyrus of Persia's reign, and all the willing, able-bodied Jewish exiles had returned to Jerusalem to start rebuilding. But Daniel, who was now in his 80's, remained behind in Babylon. He was probably too old to make the trip, and had to reconcile himself to the fact that he would never see his homeland again.

But the God Daniel served still had good plans for him. Daniel would receive one last vision, greater than all the previous ones, but this vision would rock him to his core. Daniel would speak to angels, possibly even the preincarnate Christ. He would get a glimpse of the ongoing warfare unfolding in the spiritual realm, and Daniel would ultimately receive a promise of a peaceful earthly death, followed by his resurrection and an eternal inheritance. In the last two weeks

of our study, we will examine Daniel's final

vision together.

ELOHIM

"DO NOT BE AFRAID DANIEL. SINCE THE FIRST DAY YOU SET YOUR MIND TO GAIN UNDERSTANDING AND TO HUMBLE YOURSELF BEFORE YOUR GOD, YOUR WORDS WERE HEARD, AND I HAVE COME IN RESPONSE TO THEM." (DANIEL 10:12)

The Hebrew word for God in this verse is Elohim. Elohim is the plural version of the word El, which simply means God. Somewhat like the royal "We," Elohim indicates a plural of majesty and intensity, but more than that, it indicates the fullness of Deity. "God-very God."

The word Elohim fits nicely with our concept of the Trinity, the Godhead three-in-one which includes God the Father, God the Son, and the Holy Spirit. People, living in Old Testament times, did not have a clear understanding of what the Trinity was, although we see the triune God at work all throughout Scripture. The understanding of the Trinity did not become clear until the writing of the New Testament.

SMALL GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTION

Thinking back on our study of Daniel, how have you seen each member of the Trinity at work in his life?

How would you say God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit are active in your life?

You have set your glory in the heavens...When I consider your heavens, the work of your fingers, the moon and the stars, which you have set in place, what is mankind that you are mindful of them...You have made them a little lower than the angels and crowned them with glory and honor. Amen.

DANIEL 11:36-45 & 12:1-13

This week we will continue looking at Daniel's final vision of a great war, which came to Daniel as an old man, while he was standing on the bank of the Tigris River. The vision was accompanied by a majestic figure, who came from heaven to explain what would happen to Daniel's people in the future. Towards the end of Chapter 11, the vision will shift from events that were history to us, to a time "yet to come."

First, we will have an in-depth look at the Antichrist of the Tribulation. The prefix "anti" most often means opposite or opposed to, and the Antichrist will be just that. He will appear to be a peacemaker, a savior during a time of great unrest. He will be attractive, everything about him will draw people in, but he will oppose Christ. He will be a blasphemer and he will be rebellious. He will not only oppose Christ, but he will also try to set himself up in place of Christ. He will mimic Christ so that people will want to worship him instead. Revelation tells us that he will even sustain a fatal wound. but will recover, reminiscent of Christ's resurrection.

In Daniel 12, we will conclude with glimpses into the Resurrection of the saints, the Great Tribulation, and the end of all earthly time.

THE ETERNAL GOD

Eternality speaks to God's infinite or unlimited time, without a beginning or an end. As finite creatures, it is hard for us to comprehend anything which never had a beginning. Psalm 90:2 says, "Before the mountains were born or you brought forth the whole world, from everlasting to everlasting you are God." We worship a God who was, and is, and is to come....

And yet, Scripture tells us that while we had a set beginning, we will live for eternity also. As believers, we look forward to eternity with God in heaven, but the situation is dire for those who have chosen not to follow Him. Anyone whose name is not found in the Book of Life will spend eternity in the lake of fire (Revelation 20:11-15).

SMALL GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTION Do you know where you will spend eternity? How can you be sure?

JOHN 3:16 SAYS, "GOD SO LOVED THE WORLD THAT HE GAVE HIS ONE AND ONLY SON, THAT WHOEVER BELIEVES IN HIM, WILL NOT PERISH BUT HAVE ETERNAL LIFE."

AND ROMANS 10: 13 SAYS, "EVERYONE WHO CALLS ON THE NAME OF THE LORD WILL BE SAVED."

If you are unsure about your salvation, will you trust Jesus to be your Savior? Thank Him for dying in your place, and ask Him to come into your life. Then your name will be written in the Book of Life.

PRAYER - God, we praise you as the infinite, eternal God. Thank you for creating us, and setting eternity in our hearts. We love you Lord, and want to live with You forever. If any are unsure how they stand with you, please show them the way. Amen.

CONCLUSION

This concludes our study of Daniel, a man of integrity who honorably served king and country, while remaining faithful to his God. We first met Daniel as a teenager, when he was taken captive from his homeland and brought to Babylon. We saw then that he was a person of resolve, and God protected and blessed him for it. We know that Daniel was called by God to be a prophet, and that every prophecy which has been fulfilled in the past, proved to be 100% accurate. God blessed Daniel with wisdom and insight, and through him, we have been given glimpses of our future, when earthly time will end.

Although Daniel lived 25 centuries ago, he is an example for us today on how to live a godly life in a corrupt society. Because of what we have learned from Daniel, hopefully we have made some resolutions of our own: to not be defiled, to trust God, to worship God alone, to remember, to speak truth, to pray, to belong to God, to be God's ambassador, to stay humble, and to finish well.

During the last 10 weeks, we have also learned a lot about our Sovereign God, who is completely in control of earthly history. We have seen that He alone dictates the rise and fall of world kingdoms and leaders. And we know that at the end of time, God will bring the evil powers of the universe to an end, and He will set up His eternal kingdom. As to when the end time events will take place, it is not for us to know. Jesus said, "But about that day or hour no one knows, not even the angels in heaven, nor the Son, but only the Father" (Matthew 24:36). So for now, the scroll must remain sealed, and the Lord's people must remain resolved to faithfully watch and wait.
